SUMMER MINI CAMP

Entering 4th – 8th Grades

Tailored for campers who aren't quite ready to commit to a full week of camp. Our Summer Mini Camp offers a wonderful opportunity to build confidence, gain independence, and create new friendships all while exploring the vast activities Copneconic has to offer. Campers will unplug from technology and tap into activities such as archery, kayaking, crafts, zip-lining, and much more.

OVERNIGHT CAMP

Entering 4th – 11th Grades

Overnight Camps at YMCA Camp Copneconic are where memories are made. During each of our one-week sessions, campers will unplug from technology and reconnect with nature while fishing, canoeing, and swimming. Long lasting friendships are made around the campfire, preparing for mock rock, and encouraging each other on our zip line or high ropes course.

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING (CIT)

Entering 12th Grade

The CIT program provides a unique learning opportunity to campers who are aspiring to become camp counselors or future leaders. This program is a two-week experience that includes a two-day off-site camping trip. CITs then return to camp for interactive workshops on camper management, communication skills, and leading activities. During week two, CITs put the training into action as they shadow and assist counselors with an assigned cabin group.

CRAZY ABOUT COPNECONIC

Entering 6th – 11th Grades

Two action-packed weeks of overnight camp is sure to build confidence and independence! Our two-week campers will experience age-appropriate activities with favorites like the Creek Freak zip line, kayaking, swimming, and the high ropes course. A special weekend stay is a highlight as our two-weekers enjoy all the Camp Copneconic camper's choice and evening activities.

› July 13–25

CIRCLE C RANCH

Entering 4th – 10th Grades

This program is designed for riders of all levels who want to advance their equestrian skills. Campers will be grouped based on skill and assigned their own horse for the week. Experienced staff will instruct campers on the finer points of tack, safety, equine health, grooming, identifying breeds, and respect for the animal. Half the day is spent at the Circle C Ranch and during the other half, campers take advantage of many traditional Copneconic activities.

HORSEMASTERS

Entering 8th – 11th Grades

Horsemasters is a great opportunity for riders with previous experience who want to fully immerse themselves in advancing their horse knowledge. A full day of horse time and special activities offered only during Horsemasters provides for an enriching equestrian experience. Campers must have previous riding experience.

MICHIGAN MOSAIC

Entering 9th – 11th Grades

This co-ed trip will experience a mosaic of activities, all Michigan based! This camping adventure includes adventures ranging from surfing on Lake Michigan, boating the Platte River, to going down an alpine slide. This scenic trip culminates with an excursion to Michigan's Adventure to top off an already action-packed week of fun!

Launch rockets, create simple machines, or save your egg from a 40-foot fall; our Imagination Factory has it all! This imagination-based program inspires creativity, critical thinking, and innovation. LITTLE PICASSO

Entering 1st – 4th Grades

Each day features themed projects inspired by famous artists and art movements to encourage campers to explore their artists' styles while learning about the likes of Picasso, Van Gogh and Monet. Campers will have the opportunity to create and fly water rockets, explode watermelons with rubber bands, try their hands at creating their very own robot, and more. Half the day is spent doing STEM activities and during the other half, campers take advantage of many traditional Copneconic activities.

Entering 5th – 8th Grades

Earning team points along their journey, campers learn survival skills in the rugged Copneconic wilderness. Shelter building, orienteering, fire building, fishing, and outdoor cooking are needed to succeed in this game of survival. Half the day is spent learning survival activities and during the other half, campers take advantage of many traditional Copneconic activities.

MONTHLY INSTALLMENT PROGRAM

Families have the option to spread their payments from the time of registration up to June. Installments are charged to the credit card on file on the 15th of each month with the final charge on June 15.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1 Register for camp online, over the phone, or by mailing in a registration form (forms can be obtained by printing from our website or by calling the camp office and we'll drop them in the mail to you).
- 2 Pay the deposit at the time of registration (\$75 for Overnight Camps; \$75 for Day Camps).
- 3 Your remaining balance will then be split into equal monthly payments to be paid on the 15th of each month.
- 4 The final payment will be charged on June 15.
